



CONTRACT OPERATOR

Reporting to the Foreman, the successful applicant will be part of an active team environment responsible for routine field operations. The work schedule will be determined depending on the needs of the operation.

The Field Operator position is responsible for maintaining the field to high health, safety and environmental standards while operating in a cost effective manner. This position will be required to operate any combination of oil and gas wells or battery / gas compression facilities.

This position would have the following responsibilities:

- Monitor wells, facilities and production equipment;
- Communicate and prioritize field operation requirements;
- Determine and communicate production problems to support personnel;
- Maintain accurate production records, including downtime, chemical & water injection reports;
- Coordinate shut down and startup of wells for well servicing;
- Participate in monthly safety meetings;
- Maintain daily log sheets;
- Assist with engineering strategies to optimize production;
- Offer trouble shooting and preventative maintenance to fellow operators;
- Assist with coordinating the chemical program and corrosion monitoring program, including coupons and water analysis;
- Promote Pine Cliff's safety and environmental programs and monitor related issues.
